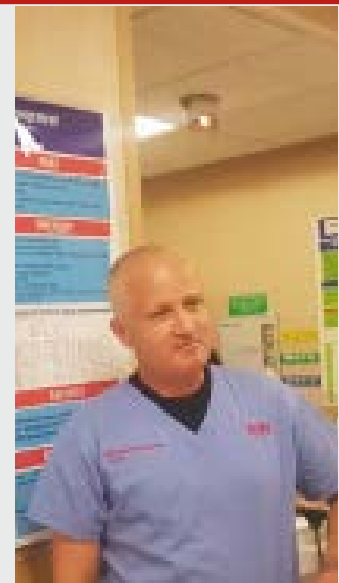

New York Hospital Queens is a 439-bed hospital that is part of the New York-Presbyterian Healthcare System. Its various departments, specifically the radiology unit, found it always possessed inventory excess or had expired stock. Before automating, their inventory management system relied solely on manual counting.



THE SOLUTION:

Smart Cabinets - for tracking high value and time sensitive items, like implants, used during surgical procedures.

StockBox - for tracking consumables, such as surgical supplies, that are only used once.

"The system provides the added benefit of being able to automatically detect when an item is nearing its expiration date, so that the hospital can more easily ensure that inventory is not overlooked, thus reducing the likelihood of products expiring prior to use. There is great value in that since the hospital had to manually manage expiration dates prior to this installation."
