

## **HOW IT WORKS**

- Passive RFID Tags are encoded at printing or applied using a pre-encoded label, linking the tag to the LIS order number. Tag carries a non-PHI key.
- Fixed RFID Readers are positioned overhead at unit exits, pneumatic-tube entry/exit, receiving thresholds, cold storage, and processing benches capture movement automatically.
- Handheld RFID Scanners quickly locate misplaced specimens—acting like a "Geiger counter" to lead staff to tagged items.
- Software Integration seamlessly connects with hospital ERP and EHR systems for centralized tracking.



# **WHAT TEAMS SEE**

**Sequence View**: shows each specimen's stage (receiving, processing, dissection, storage) with time-in-stage indicators and alerts.

**List & search**: filter by location, date, specimen type, or LIS order number.

**Location sources**: portal reads, handheld RFID scans, or barcode updates.

**Deployment**: cloud or on-prem to align with hospital IT policies.

### **RESULTS THAT MATTER**
